



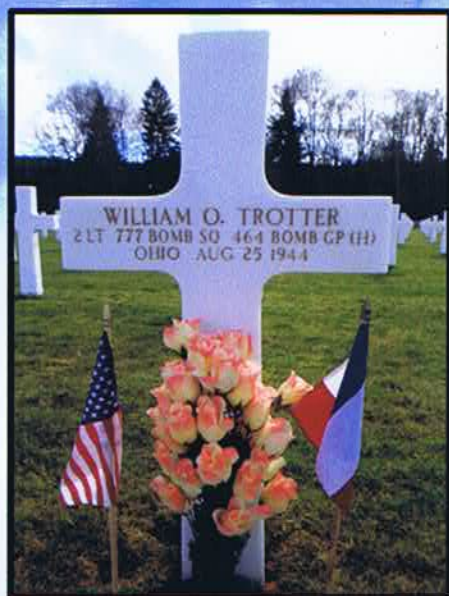
"For God and Country"

On May 25, 1944, B-24H "Lucky Lady" (SN 41-29382) was shot down while bombing a railroad junction at Givors, France. Lt. Trotter, seriously burned, parachuted to safety but was taken as prisoner. He died from his injuries while a prisoner of war on August 25, 1944. He is buried at the Epinal American Cemetery and Memorial in Dinoze', France.
