THE MEMORIAL PLAQUE

This international memorial is dedicated to the prisoners of war from 13 nations from all parts of the globe, who were incarcerated in Stalag XID and Stalag 837 from 1939-1945 during World War Two. Symbolised in the memorial are the gates, which were opened by the 8th Kings Royal Irish Hussars on 16 April 1945. Thus given freedom to the 17,000 prisoners of war held in captivity.
