 setting sun.

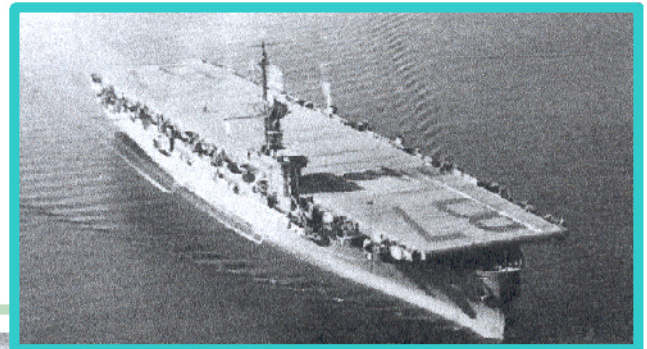
Of Carrier flying I've had my fill,

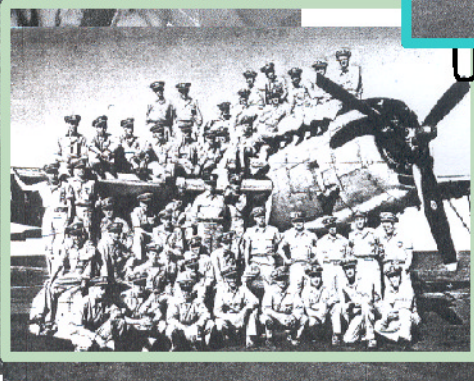
