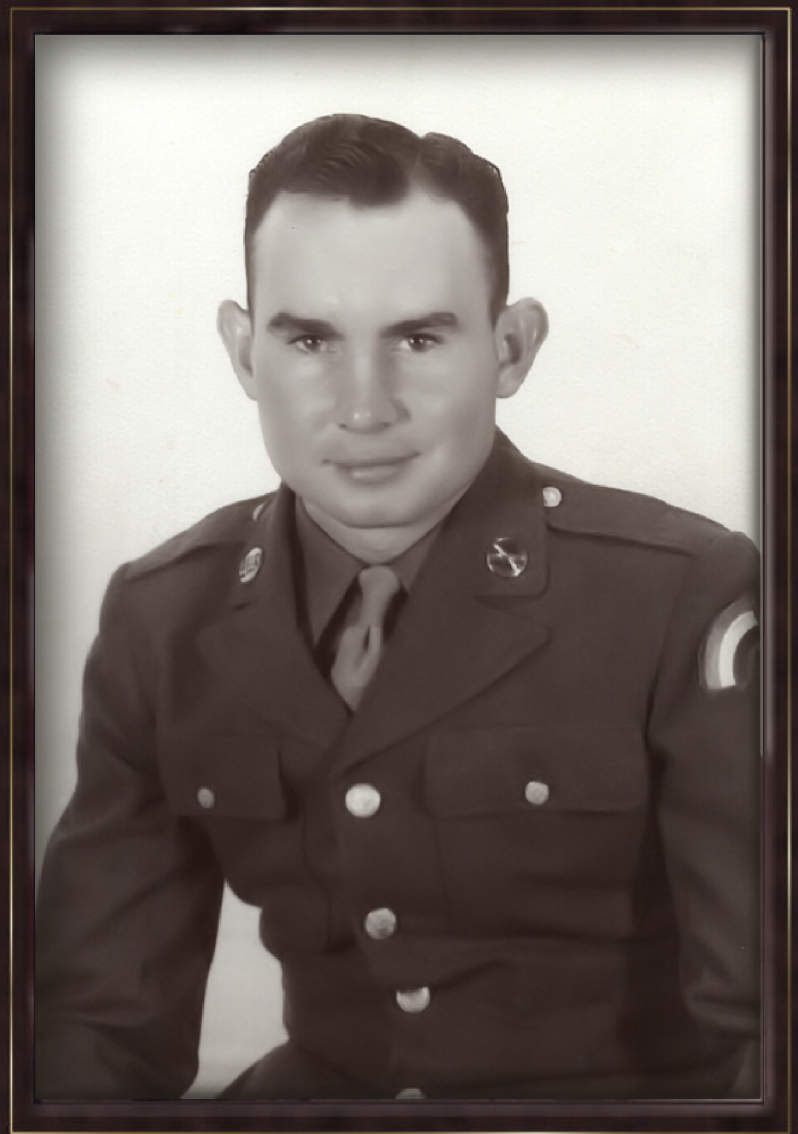
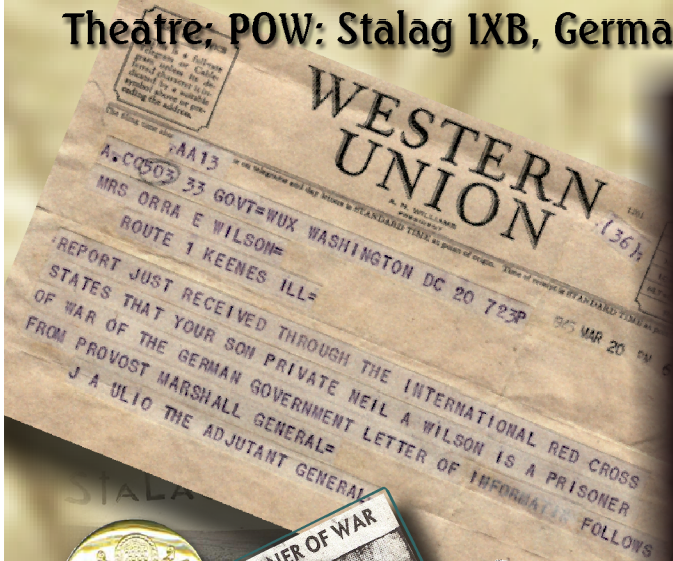


**PFC NEIL A. WILSON - ARMY**

 Reported missing in action in France January 9, Pvt. Neil A. Wilson, 18, shown above, has now been listed as a prisoner of the German government, according to a message from the War Department.

Pvt. Wilson was inducted May 25, 1944, at the age of 17. He received training at Camp Gruber, Okla., and was serving with the 42nd Division of the 7th Army at the time of his capture.

He is the son of Mrs. Orra Wilson and the late Ben Wilson of Farrington township. A card was received from him recently informing them that he was feeling fine. Prior to his induction he was employed as a farmer.
