About sick in New York City since April 29 1865. Mustered out on furlough. Muster out Oct July 6 1865 per telegram from War Dept. Sept 18 1865.

The records of this office furnish no evidence of alleged disability. Nature of sickness not stated. Regt. Hospital records not on file.
